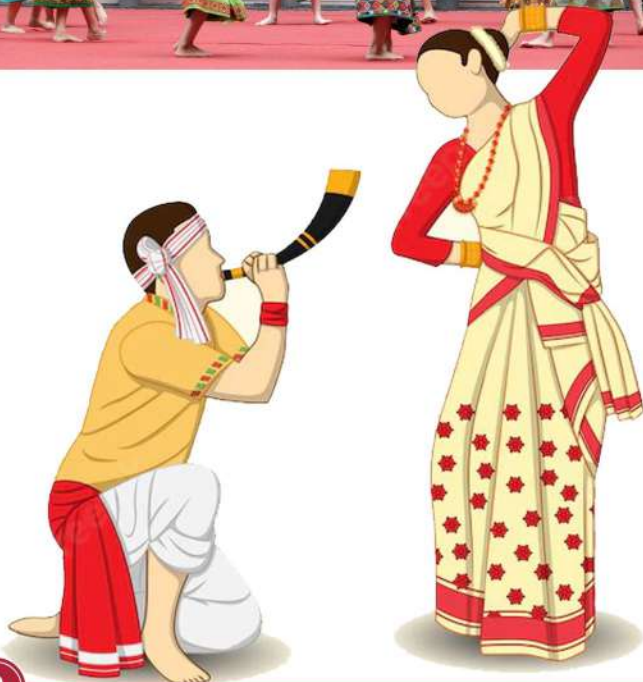


PRE-BIHU CELEBRATION

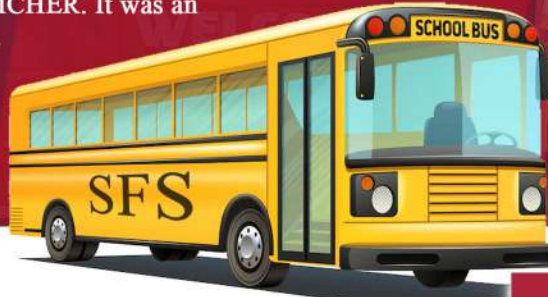




BUS STAFF TRAINING
